Scholarship Requirements

- At least one parent must be a dues paying member of the Wilber-Clatonia FFA Alumni Chapter by May 1st of the year prior to the member's graduation. Example: must be a member by May 1st of 2010 if member is graduating from High School in 2011.
- Applicant must have a grade point average of "B" or higher.
- Ag related field of study is preferred, but not required.
- Scholarship will be paid directly to the college/university. The recipient may choose to use the funds over the first two years of their education.
- The scholarship recipient must carry enough hours to be considered a full-time student in order to receive the funds.
- The FFA member must have applied for the State FFA Degree and submit his/her State FFA Degree application in addition to the scholarship application. (The application will be returned.)
- Include one letter of recommendation from someone other than the FFA advisor or family member. Please have them placed in a sealed envelope to be opened by the scholarship committee.
- Applicants may submit up to two pages of photos illustrating their SAE projects or FFA involvement.
- Applications are due to High School Guidance Counselor by April 15th of the year of graduation. The qualified completed applications will then be submitted to the W-C FFA Alumni Organization. An independent selection committee will then review the applications and select the winner.
- In year's where there are no qualified candidates, the scholarship will not be awarded.
- Only complete applications will be considered for the scholarship.
